Once again it has been brought to our attention that there may be some municipalities questioning their affiliation with the WaterWolf Planning Commission. Below are just some benefits as to why it is important that all municipalities stay on as members:

1. With your annual membership fee, you have access to a planner. If you were hiring out professional planning services, it could cost in the thousands of dollars for one contract. With WaterWolf, you have continual planning services and advice.
2. Your municipality will be guided by access to an Official Community Plan, also known as the WaterWolf Growth Management Plan. A zoning bylaw will also be provided, both of which are essential tools in the management of planning.
3. We have supplied contacts for building inspections and bylaw enforcement. In the future we will be considering a more regional approach to hiring these types of services.
4. You will be included in potential bulk buy programs (Engineering Studies, Technical Assessments) so it is cheaper per municipality.
5. We have a stronger voice as a region. Eg. A WaterWolf highways committee will have more influence on making progress with the Ministry of Highways than one municipality.
